The George Mason University Police Department UAS Unit will be hosting a 2-day, MIR approved, Public Safety UAS FAA Part 107 Preparation class. This class will consist of classroom instruction to prepare the student to sit for the FAA Part 107 exam to obtain their license to fly UAS. Total class time will be 16 hours and is approved for in-service credit. This course is designed to provide the groundwork and preparation for students to sit for the two-hour, 60 question FAA Part 107 test\* needed for public safety operations of UAS. - Flight Restrictions
- Charts
- Weather
- Maintenance and preflight
- Crew Resource Management
- Aeronautical Decision Making
- Pilot physiology
- Hazards to flight
- Emergency Procedures
